
MAP INDICATING THE LOCATION OF THE PROPERTY :❖



Development of the System for Silver Production, Transportation and Shipment over Time





- 3. (Beginning of 17th Century, (Peak of Prosperity under Tokugawa Regime))

   As the strife inside Japan subsided, Ysmabuli-jo and other fortressess surrounding the sitiver mine let out of use.

   The sitiver mine area was enciceed with fences and the potrits or entry and exit were institled with and monitored by guard sitiations. A form developed along the valley and became a tusy area.

   The shipment of sitive was taken over by another port. But, Yunotsu continued to prosper, serving to supply goods to the sitiver mine.






   The Molf Family deployed a Commissioner at Yunotau and ruled the Iwami clinzan Silver Milne and the surrounding risea.

   The transportation route from the silver mine to Yunote was developed for the transportation of silver and the delivery of materials for allver production.




