

Beware of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza!

To prevent outbreaks, it is important that each employee takes thorough measures!

- 1) Prevent wild birds, rats and other wildlife from entering
 - · Reinforce cleaning and disinfection on the farm and around the poultry houses.

Thoroughly disinfect area near ponds etc!





•Inspect and check poultry houses, etc. for wildlife entry routes,
If any holes, etc. are found, inform the Rearing Hygiene Manager

Cats can also get in through gaps in the egg collection system





Installation of dedicated boots

③ Boots should be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected, Disinfectants in disinfection tanks etc. should be changed daily (or whenever they become dirty).



Clean and then disinfect.
