Regarding the 26<sup>th</sup> Case of COVID-19 in Shimane Prefecture  
(Information Publicly Announced by Shimane Prefecture)  
【Information current as of July 22nd】

On July 21<sup>st</sup>, the patient was referred to the Consultation Center for Returning Travelers and Persons in Contact by a doctor at a medical institute. The patient later received testing with results coming back positive.

Currently, the patient is in minor condition.

1. Patient

(1) Age: 50s

(2) Gender: Male

(3) Residence: Utsunomiya City, Shimane Prefecture

(4) Infection Timeline (as told by the patient)

July 20th Trouble breathing

July 21st Received PCR testing at a medical institution and quarantined at home

2. Status of PCR Testing

Patient's travel whereabouts are being investigated and persons who have come in close contact with the patient are receiving health testing.

3. A Request to Citizens of Shimane Prefecture

- We ask citizens to act in a calm manner, based on information supplied by the Shimane Prefectural Government
- If people take action to identify the patient or cause slander, it may discourage people from providing information to the health center, as well as discourage people from coming forward in case they experience symptoms; there would be a risk that infections widely spread in Shimane.
